SUBJECT: Information regarding the  
murder of Lee Oswald

Sir:

On November 24, 1963 at approximately 11:00am, I was assigned by Lt. Swain to the basement hallway around the Texas Bureau.

I was stationed by the last window on the left of the jail office observing the people gathered there, when Oswald was brought down.

Just as Oswald was taken out the jail office door looking to the drive, I heard what sounded like a shot.

I then saw Detectives Combust, Graves, and Lavelle attempting to get Oswald, who was down, back into the jail office.

As I attempted to assist with Oswald the rush of others bringing in the suspect carried him into the jail office.

I then attempted to assist with Oswald but I was placed in the ambulance stretcher.

After the ambulance left Lt. McInerney ordered me to Parkland Hospital. I stood guard at the west end of the second floor operating room throughout the remainder of the day.
