Sir:

At approximately 10:30 A.M., November 2nd, 1973, I was working ~~in~~ as a detective assigned to the emergency room detail and was on duty station in the basement of the city hall directly in front of the pay telephone booths at the exit to the basement into the driveway parking area in the basement to await further security instructions from Captain J. L. Jones.

I stayed in this general area until Captain Jones arrived and gave instructions to about twenty-five detectives including myself, to wait placed in the line to give maximum security to the prisoner.

A blue detective's car was backed into position which blocked my view when the deceased was brought from the hallway. I saw a sudden movement from the suspect and heard a gun blast. Two or three news reporters that pushed their way forward beat I was unable to get to the suspect. I jumped across the trunk of the car and grabbed the suspect, and there were two other officers still trying to get to the gun away from him. He fell to the floor where the suspect was captured and disarmed.
