Clements dated November 30, 1963, at Dallas, Texas, sets forth two interviews by Special Agent C. Ray Hall with Jack Ruby. In the summary captioned !Investigation of Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald, Dallas, Texas, November 24, 1963, "a correction should be made on page nine under the caption "A. Movements Following" Assassination of President Kennedy. !! In the first line it is stated that Jack Ruby was interviewed by the FBI on November 24 and 25, 1963. The word/and figure "and 25" should be deleted from the end of the line to show hat Ruby was interviewed only on November 24, 1963. NOTE: See memo Rosen to Belmont 2/7/6 captioned "Jack L.
