It is noted that [CAPELL] on interview said that the statement in "Herald of Freedom" issue of 1/17/64 re visit of RUBY to Cuba "within the past year" was inaccurate. It should have read "a few years ago".

The source of information who furnished the information to [CAPELL] is not set out in FD-302 as [CAPELL] said he received this information from a confidential source who had asked him to keep his name in strict confidence.

[CAPELL] did furnish the name of his source as [GUY RICHARD, Assistant Editor of the NY Journal American newspaper] who in turn had received this information from author [NATHANIEL WEYL ("Red Star Over Cuba")]. [WEYL] is the person described in the "Herald of Freedom" article as "one of the best informed men in the United States on Soviet and Castro intelligence operations".

[CAPELL] said he was furnishing his source to the FBI in confidence and he requested that his source not be contacted by the FBI.
