Page 905. Congressman Cramer, (R) Florida, pointed out that "an Associated Press dispatch from Dallas, Tex., reported in the St. Louis Globe-Democrat dated January 21, 1964, carries the story of Jack Ruby's trip to Cuba in 1959 and other related facts as brought out in testimony at the Ruby hearings in Dallas." He included the text of the article with his remarks. The article stated "FBI Agent C. Ray Hall, last witness of the day, testified that Ruby had also told him of going to Cuba to try to sell jeeps, using a plane ticket sent to him by a person the State described as 'someone in Cuba.'" (C. Ray Hall is an Agent assigned to the Dallas Office.)
