JOAN HALIFAX, 317 Dorris St., New Orleans, advised that KLAUS WINKELMANN, a friend of hers on the staff of Tulane Univ., mentioned to her something to the fact that LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY were seen together in New Orleans by an alleged homosexual and that this homosexual who was on the staff of the Art Dept., Newcomb College, Tulane Univ., was reported to have slept with both OSWALD and RUBY. ROBERT HELLER, 4703 Freret St., New Orleans, La. was located 1/24/64 and he advised that he had received his information from SHELLY ESTRIN, Calhoun St., New Orleans. She told him that she had called [REDACTED] at Newport News, Va., one night shortly after the assassination of President KENNEDY. [REDACTED] told her that he thought that he had slept with RUBY quite some time ago. There was nothing in the conversation about OSWALD and RUBY being together in New Orleans and the only one mentioned in the conversation was RUBY. HELLER said that he knew for a fact that the allegation regarding [REDACTED] being a homosexual was true. La

Miss SHELLY ESTRIN, 541 Burgundy St., New Orleans, La. advised 1/27/64 that a few days after the assassination of President KENNEDY she had a long distance conversation with [REDACTED] who was at Newport News, Va. [REDACTED] appeared to be quite intoxicated. [REDACTED] mentioned during the conversation that he thought he had slept with RUBY some time ago. No mention was made of OSWALD. Miss ESTRIN said that [REDACTED] now lives at [REDACTED], Newport News, Va.
