DALLAS NEWSPAPERS REPORT RUBY WAS AFFORDED SECOND DAY OF NEUROLOGICAL EXAMINATION AT DALLAS NEUROLOGICAL CLINIC YESTERDAY. DALLAS MORNING NEWS TODAY INCLUDES ARTICLE STATING IT HAD LEARNED FROM UNDISCLOSED SOURCE THAT TESTS DID NOT REFLECT ANY BRAIN DAMAGE.

DEFENSE ATTORNEY TONAHILL IN TELEVISION INTERVIEW LAST NIGHT STATED THAT EVEN IF ELECTROENCEPHALOGRAPH DID NOT REVEAL BRAIN DAMAGE, SUCH WAS NOT CONCLUSIVE THAT BRAIN DAMAGE DOES NOT EXIST.

NEWS ACCOUNTS REFLECT NINETYSIX DALLAS CITIZENS, PROMINENT IN BUSINESS, LAW ENFORCEMENT, FINANCE, RELIGIOUS CIRCLES, ETC., HAVE BEEN SUBPOENAED FOR HEARING FEB TEN NEXT ON MOTION FOR CHANGE OF VENUE. IT IS SPECULATED DEFENSE CONSIDERS THESE PERSONS WILL CONCLUSIVELY SHOW FAIR TRIAL CANNOT BE HAD IN DALLAS. DIST ATTY WADE QUOTED AS STATING HE EXPECTS THESE CITIZENS WILL TESTIFY THAT JACK RUBY CAN GET A FAIR TRIAL IN DALLAS COUNTY.
