The following items of clothing worn by LEE HARVEY OSWALD at the time he was shot by JACK RUBY have been obtained from the Crime Laboratory of the Dallas Police Department at Parkland Hospital by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN:

- 1 - Black Slip-on sweater - cut open
- 1 - Undershirt - cut open
- 1 - Shirt - cut open
- 1 - Pair of dark colored trousers
- 1 - Pair of dark colored socks
- 1 - Pair of Black slip-on shoes

It is noted that according to the Police, the trousers and shoes in this listing are the same trousers and shoes he was wearing at the time he was arrested.

It is noted that the Deputy Police Chief, CHARLES BATELOR, who authorized release of this material to the FBI, has requested that it be returned to the Dallas Police Department by SA DRAIN as soon as possible.

District Attorney HENRY WADE was also contacted and he has stated he is perfectly agreeable for the material to be taken and exhibited to the Commission but he could not authorize their retaining same as he will definitely have to have the material in the trial of RUBY and it is necessary that he have this material in his possession by February 11, 1964.
