The Department has made available a copy of a letter dated 2/3/64 to Joe H. Tonahill, one of Ruby's attorneys. A copy of the letter is attached for ready reference.

The Department has also made available a copy of the enclosure which was furnished to Tonahill. This enclosure consists of the names and addresses of approximately 1,041 persons interviewed by the FBI who have been acquainted with Ruby. In some instances only the name and address of the person interviewed was given to Tonahill but in the majority of instances the name and address was supplemented with one or two sentences showing the nature of the person's association with Ruby and/or the general nature of the information he furnished. The names and addresses of those persons present when Ruby killed Oswald were included.
