Special Agent Hall will appear in answer to the subpoena, and he has been instructed that his testimony is to be limited to the results of interviews conducted by him with Ruby on November 24, 1963, and December 21, 1963. He will express no opinion as to whether or not Ruby can get a fair trial in Dallas County.
