This is to advise that Special Agent C. Ray Hall has been subpoenaed by the defense to appear in United States District Court Number 3, Dallas, Texas, on February 10, 1964, as a witness for the hearing on an application made by the defense for a change of venue. Special Agent Hall will appear in answer to the subpoena, and he has been instructed that his testimony is to be limited to the results of interviews conducted by him with Ruby on November 24, 1963, and December 21, 1963. He will express no opinion as to whether or not Ruby can get a fair trial in Dallas County. United States Attorney Barefoot Sanders will accompany Special Agent Hall in order that the Government's interest will be protected.

For your information, the defense has subpoenaed well over 100 law enforcement officers, civic, political, religious and business leaders who they hope will testify that Ruby cannot get a fair trial in Dallas County. United States Attorney Sanders was included among those subpoenaed.
