Tonahill, one of Ruby's attorneys, previously requested that full results of our investigation be made available. We deferred to the judgement of the Department and the President's Commission. The President's Commission also deferred to the Department. The Department has now furnished to Tonahill a list of the names and addresses of approximately 1,041 persons who furnished information concerning Ruby's activities or who were present when Oswald was killed. Tonahill was not furnished with the detailed results of our interviews but in most instances the name and address of the person interviewed was accompanied by one or two sentences indicating the nature of their relationship with Ruby and/or the general nature of the information they furnished.
