Immediately upon receipt Miami will interview Mary Louise Wilkinson to determine her sources for the allegation that Ruby traveled to Cuba during late 1962 and early 1963. As pointed out in referenced airtel this allegation has been received from several sources and would appear to originate within the Student Revolutionary Directorate (DRE). In addition to interviewing officials of the DRE as set forth in New Orleans teletype to the Director and Miami dated 2/5/64, you should also interview any sources available to you within the DRE in order that it may be clearly established whether or not the allegation is true or false. Leads must be handled on an expedite basis.

A lead has been forwarded to Legat Mexico City for appropriate check of Mexicana Airlines. In the future Dallas should submit leads for Legats in accordance with instructions as set forth in Handbook, Part I, page 50B.
