Dear Mr. Hoover:

This letter will confirm a request made this afternoon by a member of my staff to Mr. Malley regarding delivery of certain specified items of physical evidence tomorrow for use in taking the testimony of Marina Oswald.

If possible, the Commission would like delivered to my office at 9:15 a.m. tomorrow morning the items enumerated on the three attached lists entitled "Weapons," "Clothing," and "Cameras." In addition, we wish to request delivery also of Items C 37 and D 53, as well as a few good pictures of Jack L. Ruby, if any are available.

I would also appreciate being advised as to the status of my request contained in a letter dated February 1, 1964 for an inventory of the evidence currently in the hands of the Dallas Police Department which may be relevant to this investigation.

In order to ensure proper handling of these evidentiary items we would appreciate your making the necessary arrangements so that they might all be picked up by an agent at 5 p.m. tomorrow afternoon. At that time, we will be in a position to indicate which of these exhibits might be needed on the following day, Thursday, February 6, 1964.
