Dear Senator Tower:

Thank you for your letter of January 16, and the enclosed copy of J. Edgar Hoover's January 15th letter to you.

As you recall this was in answer to my letter regarding the possibility of the Jack Rubenstein who murdered Lee Harvey Oswald being the same Jack Rubenstein mentioned in the Dies Committee Hearings of 1929-30.

Your help is appreciated, however it looks like the "whitewash" has begun. J. Edgar Hoover's letter only told us that he would turn all findings over to the Warren Commission. This is not what we asked for. We asked for a specific answer Senator Tower. I should think that we could get a simple yes or no answer without waiting for the Warren Commission.

This could be very important to you, I and the future of our country. I think it is important enough for you to demand an answer and even to make a public issue of. If they withhold this information not telling what else they are hiding from us.

Please see if you can get a definite answer about Jack Rubenstein.
