This will confirm the telephone conversation between Mr. McGowan and Mr. Foley requesting that the report of Special Agent Clements made at Dallas on January 31, 1964, be made available to United States Attorney Sanders for perusal by the District Attorney's office in accordance with previously established procedures. Prior to making the report available it is requested that the records of the Bank of Dallas (page 97) and the records of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company commencing on page 141 be deleted. Brief summaries of some of the interviews conducted therein have been prepared and are being furnished to Mr. Tonahill, defense counsel.
