POSSIBLE BACKGROUND OF JACK RUBY

A review of the Daily Worker issue of 4/17/62, and files of NYO reflect that a testimonial dinner was held at the Astor Hotel, NYC, 4/10/62 in honor of MARK LANE. According to the Daily Worker article 1300 people attended the dinner and JACK RUBENSTEIN was listed as one of the sponsors of the dinner.

JACK RUBENSTEIN, Vice President of the Textile Workers of America, 99 University Place, Manhattan, on 2/12/64, advised SA JAMES J. ROGERS that he was one of the sponsors of the above mentioned dinner, however, he did not attend the dinner. NY

Mr. RUBENSTEIN added that when he read the speech given at the dinner by MARK LANE he sincerely regretted having agreed to act as a sponsor of the dinner.
