JACK L. RUBY, AKA., LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA. DASH VICTIM, CR.
RE DALLAS TELEPHONE CALL TO BUREAU MARCH FOUR LAST.

WITH REGARD TO ATTORNEY JOE TONAHILL'S ADVICE THAT THE PROSECUTION INTENDS TO USE AN INFORMANT BY THE NAME OF [REDACTED] TO TESTIFY FOR THE PROSECUTION TO THE EFFECT THAT SHE KNOWS OSWALD AND RUBY WERE GOOD ACQUAINTANCES AND OLD FRIENDS, IN ADDITION TO MAKING A DISCREET EFFORT TO IDENTIFY [REDACTED] AND DETERMINE HER CONNECTION WITH RUBY AND/OR OSWALD, YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT DISTRICT ATTORNEY WADE AND WITHOUT REVEALING SOURCE OF YOUR INFORMATION ASK HIM HIS INTENTIONS WITH REGARD TO CALLING AN [REDACTED] TO TESTIFY AS ABOVE AND DETERMINE FROM HIM IDENTITY OF [REDACTED] AND HER CONNECTION WITH THIS MATTER.
