A telephone call from Mr. Berlin was referred over from the Director's office at 12:07 p. m. today and in my absence, Mr. Berlin spoke with SA Fulton. Mr. Berlin stated he needed to talk to Mr. Hoover right away and when asked if it was a matter in which we could be of some assistance, he advised that it pertained to the Oswald case. He stated briefly, it concerned a story which the Hearst chain had out of Dallas that both Lee Oswald and Jack Ruby were "working" for the FBI at the time of the President's assassination. Mr. Berlin indicated that he wanted to discuss this matter personally with Mr. Hoover if at all possible and would like for Mr. Hoover to know of his call. He stated that they would not release the story until he had an opportunity to discuss the matter with the Director.

The Director's Office was immediately informed of the nature of Mr. Berlin's call and of his desire to get in touch with Mr. Hoover.
