Enclosed herewith are two copies of a letter to the Bureau from John J. Muth, Sr., wherein he furnishes information regarding one Robert E. Ingram who he says has commented that money for Ruby's defense is coming from Cuba. According to Muth, Ingram has also stated that Ruby had been trying to sell stuff to Cuba, that Oswald had been there too, and that Oswald had been in Ruby's bar the night before the assassination.

Immediately upon receipt locate and interview Robert E. Ingram and obtain full details of any information he has concerning Ruby, Oswald, association between the two, and the assassination of President Kennedy. Any leads arising from the interview which would be necessary to completely resolve Ingram's allegations must be promptly set forth and covered.

Submit results to Dallas by appropriate FD-302's (25 copies) in order that they may be included in a subsequent report. Advise Bureau of results within three days of receipt.
