JACK L. RUBY, ^{ALSO KNOWN AS} AKA; LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA, VIC, DECD; CR. CIVIL RIGHTS

DURING MORNING SESSION DEFENSE INTRODUCED FOLLOWING WITNESSES:

FREDERICK A. BEIBERDORF TESTIFIED HE, REPRESENTING CITY HEALTH DEPT, OBSERVED RUBY AT TWO ZERO FIVE PM, NOV TWENTYFOUR LAST, IN DALLAS CITY JAIL, AT WHICH TIME RUBY WAS DRESSED IN "STREET CLOTHES," THAT HE SAW HIM AGAIN ABOUT SIX PM, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS IN JAIL GARB. THIS TESTIMONY APPARENTLY INTENDED TO CONTRADICT PREVIOUS POLICE TESTIMONY BY PATRICK DEAN THAT HE SAW RUBY APPROXIMATELY TEN MINUTES AFTER SHOOTING, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS DRESSED ONLY IN UNDERSHORTS.

WITNESS TESTIFIED RUBY NOT APPARENTLY AGITATED, BUT PERSPIRING FREELY.

BARNEY ROSS, FORMER PRIZE FIGHTER, TESTIFIED GREW UP WITH RUBY IN CHICAGO. TESTIMONY APPARENTLY INTENDED TO SHOW RUBY'S UNSTABLE AND HIGHLY EMOTIONAL CONDITION AT THAT TIME. IN CROSS EXAMINATION, ROSS STATED DID NOT RECALL TELLING FBI WHEN INTERVIEWED THAT RUBY WAS A WELL-BEHAVED, QUIET INDIVIDUAL AND NOT A TROUBLEMAKER. 11 1964

GEORGE SENATOR, WHO WAS LIVING WITH RUBY AT TIME OF OFFENSE, TESTIFIED AS TO RUBY'S HIGHLY EMOTIONAL STATE AND DETAILS OF ACCOMPANYING RUBY EARLY MORNING HOURS NOV TWENTYTHREE LAST TO PHOTOGRAPH "IMPEACH EARL WARREN" SIGN, WHICH RUBY BELIEVED CONNECTED WITH ANTI-KENNEDY ADVERTISEMENT WHICH APPEARED IN LOCAL NEWSPAPER. TESTIFIED AS TO RECEIPT OF PHONE CALL BY RUBY MORNING OF NOV TWENTYFOUR LAST FROM LITTLE LYNN, STRIPPER, AND HEARING RUBY TELL HER HE WOULD SEND MONEY ORDER BY WESTERN UNION. TESTIFIED RUBY LEFT APARTMENT WITHOUT ANY INDICATION OF BEING IN A HURRY, TOOK DOG WITH HIM. TESTIFIED RUBY NEVER AT ANY TIME MENTIONED TO HIM HAVING SEEN OSWALD, NOR DID HE MENTION OSWALD TO SENATOR IN ANY CONNECTION.

PATRICIA KOHS AKA PENNY DOLLAR, STRIPPER, IN CUSTODY ORANGE, TEXAS, ON NARCOTICS CHARGE, BROUGHT TO DALLAS TO TESTIFY. STATED OBSERVED RUBY KNOCK CAB DRIVER DOWNSTAIRS AT CAROUSEL CLUB, BEAT HIS HEAD ON SIDEWALK, AND IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER ASK, "DID I DO THIS?" IN CROSS EXAMINATION TESTIFIED RUBY PUBLICITY SEEKER, NAME DROPPER, EGOTIST, ALWAYS WANTED TO BE IN LIMELIGHT.

ROY A. ~~TRYOR~~, PRINTER, DALLAS TIMES HERALD, TESTIFIED HAD KNOWN RUBY SINCE NINETEEN FIFTY, WORKED FOR RUBY AT SILVER SPUR CLUB AS MUSICIAN, MASTER OF CEREMONIES AND COMIC IN EARLY FIFTIES, OBSERVED RUBY WAS ALWAYS HIGHLY EMOTIONAL INDIVIDUAL. TESTIFIED SAW RUBY EARLY MORNING HOURS NOV TWENTYTHREE AT TIMES HERALD, AT WHICH TIME RUBY TOLD HIM HAD SEEN OSWALD AND ATTENDED PRESS CONFERENCE AT CITY HALL PREVIOUS NIGHT. RUBY WAS ELATED OVER "SCOOPING" COMPETITORS BY CHANGING PREVIOUSLY PLACED NEWSPAPER ADS TO SHOW THAT RUBY CLUBS WOULD BE CLOSED DUE TO ASSASSINATION AND FOR PERIOD OF KENNEDY FUNERAL. ON CROSS EXAMINATION, TESTIFIED RUBY WAS ELATED OVER HAVING SEEN OSWALD NIGHT OF NOV TWENTYTWO, REFERRED TO OSWALD AS "WEASEL OF A GUY." TESTIFIED RUBY WAS A PUBLICITY SEEKER, ALWAYS WANTING TO BE IN LIMELIGHT
