ON MARCH SIX INSTANT MR. VERN L. ROGOSCH, GENERAL COMMERCIAL SUPERINTENDENT, CENTRAL TELEPHONE COMPANY, SOUTHERN NEVADA DIVISION, LAS VEGAS, NEVADA ADVISED SA DONALD M. HOLLAND THAT NONE OF THE RECORDS OF THE TELEPHONE COMPANY AT LAS VEGAS CAN BE REVIEWED OR OBTAINED BY THE FBI WITHOUT THE ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM OR COURT ORDER.

ROGOSCH ADVISED THAT THE ABOVE IS THE POLICY OF THE CENTRAL TELEPHONE COMPANY.

ROGOSCH STATED THAT THE COMPANY RETAINS TOLL RECORDS ONLY FOR A SIX MONTH PERIOD, HOWEVER, HE BELIEVES THE COMPANY STILL HAS RECORDS GOING BACK TO SEPTEMBER NINETEEN SIXTY-THREE. THE SEPTEMBER SIXTY THREE RECORDS WILL BE DESTROYED IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

BUREAU REQUESTED TO ADVISE IF SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM OR COURT ORDER CAN BE OBTAINED AT WASHINGTON FOR TOLL INFORMATION ON TELEPHONE OF LEWIS J. MC WILLIE, THREE SIX TWO SEVEN EASTERN, LAS VEGAS.
