It is noted that LABRO did not interview RUBY on November 23, 1963 as alleged but did have a casual conversation with him on the third floor of Dallas police headquarters on November 23, 1963. OSWALD was not mentioned during the conversation and there was no indication that RUBY was acquainted with OSWALD.
