Dear Mr. Hoover:

Thank you for your letter of February 18, 1964, in which you forwarded to us a complete set of medical records of Fannie Rubenstein obtained from Elgin State Hospital, Elgin, Illinois.

A report incorporated therein from the Psychopathic Hospital of Cook County, Illinois, (a duplicate of which is attached hereto), indicates that other reports on members of the Ruby family may be available through other agencies in Illinois. The Psychopathic Hospital makes particular reference to the following reports: JFE 11-25-32, JSSB C. 3-32, Rest Haven 8-11-30, JFE 7-13-29, WL. 6-30-27, JHFS 2-15-26, MTS Racine 3-25-24, IJR 43-76 7-6-22.

The Commission would appreciate your obtaining and forwarding to it copies of those reports. In all probability, the report designated IJR 43-76 7-6-22 is identical to a report which has already been subpoenaed by the Commission from the Institute of Juvenile Research in Illinois. If that is true, it will be sufficient for your agency to indicate that we have already subpoenaed that document.
