Enclosed herewith are two copies of a letter to the Bureau from the President's Commission received March 9, 1964, requesting that we obtain reports of members of the Ruby's family which may be available through agencies in Illinois. Also enclosed is a copy of a report from the Psychopathic Hospital of Cook County, Illinois, which according to the Commission indicates that such other reports may be available.

Promptly upon receipt initiate investigation to identify and obtain copies of the reports as requested by the Commission advising persons contacted that the investigation is being conducted at the specific request of the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy. Within three days of receipt of this communication submit results by enclosure to a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination.

NOTE: Commission by letter dated 2/12/64 requested that we obtain copies of the medical records of Fannie Rubenstein (mother of Jack Ruby) available at the Elgin State Hospital, Elgin, Ill. This was done and results submitted to the Commission by letter 2/18/64. A portion of the record obtain from Elgin

State Hospital was a report from the Psychopathic Hospital of Cook County, Ill. This report classified Fannie Rubenstein as "Paranoid state with some deterioration" and listed her husband and children with their names and ages. In a column opposite (See Note Continued Page Two.)
