RUBY. SHE?CLAIMED THAT RABBI SILVERMAN EARLIER TODAY HAD TALKED WITH RUBY IN HIS CELL AT DALLAS COUNTY JAIL AND DURING CONVERSATION RUBY ALLEGEDLY EXPRESSED THE BELIEF THAT THE JAILERS ASSIGNED TO HIS SECURITY IN THE COUNTY JAIL WERE GOING TO KILL HIM. MRS. GRANT IN-SISTED THAT IHIS OFFICE IMMEDIATELY DISPATCH AGENTS TO THE COUNTY JAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROTECTION FOR RUBY DURING THE REMAINDER! OF HIS TRIAL AND ANY FUTURE CONFINEMENT. SHE WAS TACTFULLY ADVISED THAT THIS BUREAU HAD NO AUTHORITY OR RESPONSIBILITY. AND IT WAS SUGGEST-ED THAT SHE MAKE HER COMPLAINT KNOWN TO SHERIFF DECKER. SHE THEN CLAIMED SHE HAD NO CONFIDENCE IN SHERIFF DECKER AND THAT HE OF THE CONSPIRACY.
