Dear Mr. Hoover:

Thank you for your letter of March 10, 1964, in which you report that telephone records relating to Mr. Lewis J. McWillie may be destroyed by the Central Telephone Company, Southern Nevada Division, Las Vegas, Nevada, in the near future. I have requested that the telephone company refrain from further destruction of records until May 1, 1964.

This Commission would appreciate your advising us as to the telephone numbers at the place at which McWillie resides and at which he works, including pay phones at the latter place.

In addition, the Commission would like to be advised as to the information in your files, other than that already supplied, relating to Mr. McWillie with particular reference to his activities in Cuba and in connection with Cuban armament sales.
