I have received your letter of March 3rd.

Although I would like to be of assistance to you in connection with your inquiry concerning an alleged organization named "Fenster," information contained in the files of the FBI is confidential and available for official use only, pursuant to regulations of the Department of Justice.

Since narcotics violations do not fall within the jurisdiction of this Bureau, I am taking the liberty of referring a copy of your letter to the Bureau of Narcotics, United States Treasury Department, Washington, D. C., for any assistance it may be able to afford you.

NOTE: Mr. Kretschy is on the Bureau's mailing list to receive the Law Enforcement Bulletin. We have enjoyed prior correspondence with him, last outgoing 12-27-63. "Offentliche Sicherheit" is an illustrated monthly review published by the Austrian Federal Ministry of the Interior. The "Syra" to which he refers is believed to be "Siri the Dutch Doll," which is the trade name of Marjorie Alice Putnam, a strip-tease dancer in Hollywood, California. Putnam was interviewed by the FBI on 12-26-63, in connection with the Jack Ruby investigation at which time she advised that she did not know Ruby or Lee Harvey Oswald and had never worked in Ruby's club. On the basis of information available, it was not possible to identify the alleged underground organization, "Fenster."
