"Offentliche Sicherheit" is an illestrated monthly review published by the Austrian Federal Ministry of the Interior. The "Syra" to which he refers is believed to be Siri'the Dutch Doll," which is the trade name of Marjorie Alice Putnam, a strip-tease dancer in Hollywood, California. Putnam was interviewed by the FBI on 12-26-63, in connection with the Jack Ruby investigation at which time she advised that she did not know Ruby or Lee Harvey Oswald and had never worked in Ruby's club. On the basis of information available, it was not possible to identify the alleged underground organization, "Fenster."
