All of the attachments are copies of documents in the possession of the Jewish Children's Bureau, Chicago, Illinois, which were made available by Mrs. [REDACTED]. These were the only documents requested obtained by this Bureau pursuant to the Commission's request.

The Commission, in its request for copies of reports relative to the Jack Ruby family, referred to an "IJR Report 43-76, 7/6/22", which was probably identical to the report already subpoenaed by the Commission from the Institute for Juvenile Research (IJR).

Doctor Raymond E. Robertson, Psychiatrist in Charge, IJR, Chicago, Illinois, advised this Bureau on March 13, 1964 that as of that date IJR file 43-76 relative to Jacob Rubenstein (Jack Ruby) had not been subpoenaed.
