(SIMON B. FRIEDMAN), Assistant Executive Director, Jewish Vocational Bureau, 1. South Franklin, Chicago, Illinois, provided the following information:

His agency was formerly known as the Jewish Free Employment Bureau (JFEB). The records of his agency contain no information concerning JOSEPH RUBENSTEIN, his wife FANNY, or their children HYMAN, ANNA, MARY, EVA, JAKE, SAM, ISADORE, and IDA. He advised that in the event the RUBENSTEIN family above had been in contact with his agency, his records would have been destroyed because of his agency's continuing policy of record destruction. He stated that employment assistance records are destroyed after five years of no activity, while records concerning more extensive service to the family are destroyed after ten years of no activity.

(FRIEDMAN) advised that the JFEB had been founded in 1920, and that its name had been officially changed to Jewish Vocational Service and Employment Service in 1936.
