Dr. RAYNOND E. ROBERTSON, Psychiatrist.in Charge, Institute of Juvenile Research (IJR), 907 South Wolcott, Chicago, Illinois, advised that the report referred to by the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy entitled: "IJR 43-76 7-6-22," undoubtedly referred to IJR file 4376. Dr. ROBERTSON stated that this file to date has not been subpoenaed by the President's Commission on the Assassination and that in addition to the original inquiry by the FBI in December, 1963, the only person contacting IJR relative to RUBY had been a member of the Chicago press who had been turned away without having been provided any information.

any information. Dr. ROBERTSON stated that IJR file 4376 relates to JACOB RUBENSTEIN, also known as JACK RUBY, and that it consists of approximately 50 microfilm records. He advised that in view of this, in the event the record is subpoenaed, he would be willing to prepare a summary of the file and forward it along with the file itself if such a request is made.

Dr. ROBERTSON stated that he wished to __ :: cooperate in every way possible, but that because of the nature of the information contained in the file, he did not believe that he could release it unless the file were subpoended or JACK RUBY authorized its release.
