Dallas Office has heretofore furnished Bureau information relative to all file references to JACK L. RUBY prior to institution of this investigation. Information from files relative to EVA GRANT, sister, and SAMUEL DAVID RUBY, Brother, has been previously reported as has information from files relative to Carousel Club and Vegas Club. Considerable background information relative to and interviews with RUBY's brothers and sisters in Dallas, Chicago and Detroit, has been reported heretofore.

Previous reports have included interviews with GEORGE SENATOR, CURTIS LA VERNE CRAWFORD, ANDREW ARMSTRONG, LEWIS J. MC WILLIE, KAREN BENNETT CARLIN, ROY WILLIAM PIKE, aka Mike Ryan, LAURENCE MEYERS, ALEXANDER P. GRUBER, FRANK GOLDSTEIN, ROBERT BAKER, aka Barney Baker, and ABE WEINSTEIN.

Indices of Dallas Office are negative, except as to WEINSTEIN, re above individuals prior to institution of this investigation.

Certain information is set out in the introductory pages of this report regarding various individuals whose toll charges are of concern to the President's Commission, for the purpose only of showing the availability of telephones to such persons. Certain offices have furnished information from indices regarding some of these individuals as well as subscribers to certain of the telephone numbers called by them. None of the information furnished shows any connection with JACK L. RUBY and accordingly is not being set out in the body of this report. Such information is summarized hereinafter for the Bureau's information.

Dallas indices include a number of references to ABE WEINSTEIN in connection with WEINSTEIN's operation of the Colony Club, Dallas, a burlesque club. No references connect WEINSTEIN, except as a competitor, with RUBY.

The San Francisco Office has informed that office is origin in the case entitled "FRANK GOLDSTEIN, ITMI", which was initially opened in the San Francisco Office on November 14, 1961 on the basis of an allegation from a confidential informant that GOLDSTEIN was a professional bookmaker. Investigation has established from other informants that GOLDSTEIN has operated a

local sporting event book for several years and has no other gainful employment. Insufficient evidence of interstate book-making has been developed to date to present the case for prosecution. Investigation of GOLDSTEIN's gambling activities is continuing.

The Los Angeles Office has noted in connection with the above investigation that numerous telephone calls were made by GOLDSTEIN to MORRIS GOLDSTEIN, Santa Monica, California, whose name appears in the body of this report as the subscriber to a telephone called by GOLDSTEIN during the pertinent period. MORRIS GOLDSTEIN was identified by the Los Angeles Office as a shoe salesman formerly employed by Karl's Shoe Store, Los Angeles, and as having come from New York to Los Angeles several years ago.

Los Angeles has noted GOLDSTEIN previously had made telephone calls to THEODORE SCHOENFELD, Los Angeles, whose number was also called by GOLDSTEIN during the pertinent period of instant investigation. SCHOENFELD, according to credit records, was shown to be the owner of Magna Film and St. Francisco Garage, both Los Angeles.

Los Angeles has noted LILY ROSE LYNCH, nee Bernstein, aka, clerk-typist, Regional Office, Veteran's Administration, Los Angeles, was [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Los Angeles noted no derogatory information was developed on this person. LILLY R. LYNCH, Venice, California, was one of the persons called from GOLDSTEIN's number during the period pertinent to this investigation.

Salt Lake City Office has noted in connection with investigation of FRANK GOLDSTEIN, ITWI, that EVA V. SERGAKIS, Salt Lake City, Utah, is the mother-in-law of GOLDSTEIN. It was noted this individual was called from GOLDSTEIN's number during the period pertinent to this investigation.

The Omaha Office has noted that indices reflect an article appeared in the "Omaha World Herald", daily newspaper, issue of June 23, 1963, reflecting ROBERT (BARNEY) BAKER, an organizer for the Teamsters Union, had been released from Federal

Prison, Sandstone, Minnesota, after serving eighteen months of a two year sentence imposed January 28, 1961 in USDC, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, along with a \$1200 fine, for extorting \$525 from the president of a trucking firm in McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania. The article continues that BAKER was married to CAROLINE MORE, daughter of former Iowa Democratic State Chairman JAKE MORE of Harlan, Iowa. It is noted JAKE MORE was the recipient of a telephone call from one of the telephones available to BAKER during the period pertinent to this investigation.

The Denver Office has noted that telephone 333-8193, Denver, recipient of several calls from telephones available to BAKER, above, is the non-published number of SONNY LISTON, aka Charles Sonny Liston, former heavyweight boxing champion, concerning whom information appears in Criminal Intelligence Digest, 7/18/63.

Indianapolis Office has noted that investigation has been conducted in a case entitled "JAMES RIDDLE HOFFA; EARL SCHEIB Auto Paint Shops; ET AL, MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION CONCERNING", Los Angeles origin, Bufile 63-7112. It is noted numerous telephone calls have been placed from telephones available to BAKER to various offices of the EARL SCHEIB Company, a national chain. U.S.

New York and Springfield Offices have noted EARL A. SCHEIB was shown as president of Jackson Chemical Company in the case entitled "UNION BANK AND TRUST COMPANY of Los Angeles, Los Angeles, California; ET AL, FRA-Conspiracy".

St. Louis Office has identified telephone numbers called from the residence of ROBERT BAKER as being listed to the residence and office of STANLEY M. ROSENBLUM, St. Louis attorney. St. Louis reported background investigation was conducted on ROSENBLUM in September, 1946 in the case entitled "JULIAN MARTIN, aka Espionage-R&C", Washington Field origin. St. Louis noted ROSENBLUM, who had already been discharged from military service, was described as a friend of MARTIN. Washington Field has informed MARTIN was found guilty in Army court martial proceedings. St. Louis also noted that in the case entitled "JAMES RIDDLE HOFFA, aka, LMRA-DM-CONSPIRACY", St. Louis conducted investigation to identify one of the telephones of ROSENBLUM which had apparently been called by the Teamsters Union Welfare Fund, Detroit, Michigan. Kansas City Office has noted that investigation was conducted in 1948 in a case entitled "Gateway Sporting Goods Company, LOUIS A. CUMONOW, owner, Neutrality Act", Bufile 2-9444, New York origin. Investigation reflected Gateway shipped over 500,000 ammunition primers to United Lumber Company, St. Louis, Missouri, reshipped to Palestine. It is noted Gateway Sporting Goods Company, Kansas City, Missouri, was the subscriber to a telephone called from a telephone available to LAURENCE V. MEYERS, Chicago, at Ero Manufacturing Company.

It is noted a telephone call was made from the Ero Manufacturing Company number, Chicago, to one GIBSON, Pagosa Springs, Colorado, with the use of a credit card. *col*

DALLAS TEXAS
Denver Office determined from H. J. CATCHPOLE, owner, Harvey's Motel, Pagosa Springs, Colorado, that HERBERT R. GIBSON, 2620 Main Street, Dallas, who owns Gibson Products, Dallas, and operates several discount stores, was a guest of the motel at the time of the telephone call involved. It is observed that a telephone call was made from Ero Manufacturing Company to Gibson's Tri-State Wholesale, Inc., Monroe, Louisiana, which has been identified as a chain discount house. *TEXAS*

Files of Dallas Office reflect that information was received on 2/6/43 that HERBERT R. GIBSON, owner of Gibson Products Company, Dallas, was a dealer in drug sundries with branch offices in several states. Credit records reflected at that time that on 10/3/31, GIBSON had pleaded guilty in Federal Court, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to the interstate transportation of rubber contraceptives and had been sentenced to one year and one day in the U. S. Penitentiary, Leavenworth. Credit records indicated GIBSON had also been arrested, date and place unknown, for peddling obscene literature.

Indianapolis Office has identified a telephone number called from the company phone of ROBERT BAKER to Hammond, Indiana as being listed to one CLAUDE N. MAYBERRY, Hammond. Indices of Indianapolis Office reflect one GORDON MAYBERRY representing NAACP, spoke at a mass meeting in Hammond in 1951, in protest of the shooting of one GEORGE HALL by a Hammond, Indiana Police Department officer.

New Orleans Office has identified the subscriber of a telephone called from Dallas, Texas from a telephone available to ABE WEINSTEIN as Sterk Club, Bossier City, Louisiana owned by MIKE THEODOS. New Orleans noted a Dallas origin case entitled "MIKE THEODOS; ET AL; PATRICIA BIRCH KOHS, aka - VICTIM, WSTA". Investigation in this matter did not develop a violation. It is noted Victim KOHS, as PENNY DOLLAR, is a stripper who formerly worked at RUBY's Carousel Club in Dallas.

New Orleans noted THEODOS is also subject of "MICHAEL THEODOS, aka, AR", New Orleans origin, closed in 1961. New Orleans was also origin in "MICHAEL THEODOS, IGA-Wire Service" to determine whether THEODOS was engaged in bookmaking activities. The case has been closed, no substantial information has been developed.

Indices of Dallas Office reflect C. A. "PAPPY" DOLSEN, Dallas, Texas, whose telephone number was called from the Fort Worth, Texas number available to BRUCE and ERKEN BENNETT CARLIN, has been engaged in show business in Dallas for many years as a producer and booking agent. He is known to book striptease performers. He formerly operated a dance hall known as PAPPY'S Showland. His name is indexed as a source of information in two WSTA cases, both closed. DOLSEN was reported on 5/16/58 to have been operating a nightclub and gambling establishment near Dallas, frequented by known hoodlums. DOLSEN currently carried as a PCI of the Dallas Office, DL 137-1378. TEXAS

BARNEY WEINSTEIN, 1326 Jackson Street, Dallas, whose telephone number at Theatre Lounge, Dallas, was called from the telephone available to the CARLINS, is identified in Dallas files as a brother of ABE WEINSTEIN who operates the Colony Club. Theatre Lounge is a striptease establishment and it is known that KAREN BENNETT CARLIN, aka Little Lynn, has performed at this establishment.
