ReDLlet to Bureau dated 4/1/64 entitled "'Minutemen' Information Concerning (Internal Security)" Dallas file 105-1280.

Referenced letter sets forth on page 10 information obtained by the Oklahoma City Office from Mr. T. V. Stephens indicating that one Morris Tannehill of Dallas has alleged that it is well known that Jack Ruby has been mixed in with the Communists and that Ruby had a plane chartered to go to Mexico the day of Lee Harvey Oswald's assassination but did not go.

If not already done, you should immediately interview Tannehill for full details of any information he may have indicating Ruby as being mixed in with Communists and determine the basis for his statement that Ruby had a plane chartered to go to Mexico. Any logical leads arising from the interview which are necessary to thoroughly and completely resolve the allegations of Tannehill must also be promptly handled. Include results in the next report submitted in this case.
