Earl Ruby, brother of Jack Ruby, advised the Dallas Office 3/23/64 that Ferris had sent a telegram to Melvin Belli, Ruby's former attorney, which stated he had valuable information to assist Ruby. Investigation to locate Ferris indicates that he resides in Roanoke, Va., and was recently released from a VA hospital where he was treated as a mental patient. He travels constantly and his mental condition is reportedly deteriorating. In view of telegram to Belli, Richmond has been instructed to locate Ferris for interview.
