On April 9, 1964, SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS encountered
EVA GRANT, RUBY's sister, in the lobby of the Dallas County
Jail. Mrs. GRANT is a very voluble person and volunteered, as
she has on each occasion, much unsolicited information. She
mentioned she had been permitted to visit RUBY almost daily, despite the normal regulations specifying particular visiting
days. She mentioned further that attorneys were as of that
date filing additional papers in connection with their seeking
a new trial.
Of particular interest, Mrs. GRANT stated "we" have
obtained a copy of a Dallas Police report through a person
"who thought we ought to have it". She described the report
in question as one which went back to November 13, 1963, and
told of police preparations for visit of President KENNEDY to
Dallas and went through the events surrounding the shooting
of OSWALD.
