On April 9, 1964, SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS encountered EVA GRANT, RUBY's sister, in the lobby of the Dallas County Jail. Mrs. GRANT is a very voluble person and volunteered, as she has on each occasion, much unsolicited information. She mentioned she had been permitted to visit RUBY almost daily, despite the normal regulations specifying particular visiting days. She mentioned further that attorneys were as of that date filing additional papers in connection with their seeking a new trial.

Of particular interest, Mrs. GRANT stated "we" have obtained a copy of a Dallas Police report through a person "who thought we ought to have it". She described the report in question as one which went back to November 13, 1963, and told of police preparations for visit of President KENNEDY to Dallas and went through the events surrounding the shooting of OSWALD.

Examination of a 34-page document dated November 30, 1963, addressed to Mr. J. E. CURRY, Chief of Police, signed by CHARLES BATCHELOR, Assistant Chief of Police; GEORGE L. LUMPKIN and M. W. STEVENSON, Deputy Chiefs of Police, discloses

same is a chronological account, beginning November 13, 1963, of police activities prior to, during and after the assassination, and including the shooting of OSWALD. Copies were furnished Bureau on December 31, 1963. This would appear to be the report to which Mrs. GRANT referred.

Chief CURRY and District Attorney HENRY WADE are being informed of the possession of this report by the defense.
