Enclosed herewith are two copies of a letter to the Attorney General from Miss Mary Jone dated 4/7/64 wherein she states she has information about an attorney at 17 - 2nd Street, Phoenix, Arizona, who always sends money to help Jack Ruby.

Immediately upon receipt interview Mary Jone for full details as to the basis for the statement in her letter. In the event she furnishes some reasonable basis for her statement, identify and interview the attorney to determine whether or not he has a connection with Ruby and any information he may have regarding Ruby, the assassination of President Kennedy, or any possible connection between Ruby and Oswald. Any further logical leads developed should be promptly handled.

If Jone cannot supply a reasonable basis for her statement, conduct sufficient inquiry through an indices check and reliable sources of your office to determine whether or not such an attorney exists and, if so, who he is and what he does.
