The information referred to above as requested by the Commission pertains to some certain allegations received in early stages of investigation (1) that Ruby participated in Communist Party meetings in Muncie, Indiana, in 1947, (2) in Communist Party meetings in Muncie, Indiana, in 1947, (2) that he was engaged in Cuban gun-running activities, and (3) that he was in the printing business in Chicago in 1942. The allegations were for the most part fully run out within a week or two after Ruby shot Oswald but as the results were completely negative and did not pertain to the civil rights provided aspects of the investigation they were not reported. The enclosed report has been reviewed by Mr. Belmont, Mr. Malley and the appropriate supervisor in the Civil Rights Section. A copy is being furnished to the Criminal Division of the Department. The Department has previously advised that inasmuch as the Ruby trial is completed they do not desire that we furnish further reports in this matter to USA Sanders in Dallas.
