The President's Commission, by letter 6/8/64, stated that as a result of deposing Crowe, aka Bill Dellar, they desired the enclosed investigation to verify his deposition. Crowe is the nightclub performer for Jack Ruby who stated publicly after the shooting of Oswald by Ruby that he had seen Oswald in Ruby's Carousel Club a short time before the assassination. In our interview of Dellar he was not certain of the identity of the person he allegedly saw and could not state positively that it was Oswald.
