NOTE:

Immediately after Ruby's arrest for the shooting of Oswald, we examined his bank accounts at the Merchants State Bank, Dallas. The Commission by letter 8/13/64 requested that we re-examine these accounts (one in his name, one in the name of the Carousel Club and one in the name of the Vegas Club) to determine what, if any, activity there had been in these accounts since November 24, 1963. All of these accounts are now closed.
