THIS DATE, ROBERT G. STOREY, HOME ADDRESS THREE FIVE TWO  
FIVE TURTLE CREEK DRIVE, DALLAS, TEXAS, CURRENTLY ATTENDING  
THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION, ATLANTIC CITY, NJ, AND  
RESIDING AT HADDON HALL, THAT CITY, ADVISED THAT UPON THE  
SHOOTING OF OSWALD, GOVERNOR CONNELLY OF TEXAS, LEON  
JAWORSKI OF HOUSTON, AND HIMSELF TO A SPECIAL COURT OF INQUIRY,  
THE PURPOSE BEING TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE DEATH  
OF OSWALD.

ON JUNE SEVEN SIXTYFOUR, STOREY WAS ONE OF SEVERAL WHO  
INTERVIEWED JACK RUBY IN THE COUNTY JAIL, DALLAS, TEXAS.  
STOREY STATED HE INTERVIEWED RUBY FOR TWO OR MORE HOURS  
ON THAT DATE.
