Re Bureau airtel June 5, 1964, which transmitted Commission's letter of June 4, 1964.

The Commission's letter, in part, requested the FBI to ascertain the existence of phonographic records and papers, which former Dallas County Sheriff STEVE GUTHRIE claimed were made in connection with the Dallas Crime Investigation, 1946-1948, and if they do exist, how they are now maintained, how extensive they are, and whether or not they are indexed to show any mention of RUBY.
