The above transcript notes that the first seven recordings were not transcribed in detail, inasmuch as they were not considered pertinent to the matter in question.

The detailed transcript concerned two specific meetings.

1. Meeting between PAUL JONES; STEVE GUTHRIE, Sheriff Elect; and GEORGE BUTLER, Dallas Police Department on Friday night, 8:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m., November 1, 1946, at the home of STEVE GUTHRIE.
2. Meeting between PAUL JONES; JACK KNAPP; PAT MANNING, Sheriff Elect; STEVE GUTHRIE, Dallas County; and Detective GEORGE BUTLER, Dallas Police Department, held at the home of STEVE GUTHRIE, Dallas, Texas, on November 7, 1946.

Examination of this material contains no mention of JACK RUBY, nor do the indices of this subcommittee contain any reference to RUBY.

It is noted that Dallas is attempting to monitor the records and if necessary, a copy of the above transcript may be obtained by directing a letter through appropriate channels to Mr. JEROME ADLERMAN, General Counsel, Senate Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations, Senate Office Building, WDC.
