Dear Mrs. Ruby:

Your letter to the Attorney General dated August 18, 1964, has been referred to me for reply.

I wish to assure you that this Department's Federal Bureau of Investigation has never at any time placed or caused to be placed any monitoring device or so-called "wire tap" on the telephone line of either Samuel D. Ruby or Mrs. Eva Grant, nor has it done so with respect to the telephone line of any other member of Jack L. Ruby's family.

On the contrary, I have been informed that a complete check of the telephone lines of Samuel D. Ruby and Mrs. Eva Grant was made on August 25, 1964, and disclosed no evidence to indicate that any monitoring device had ever been used on either of those lines.
