Reference is made to your letter of July 23, 1964 requesting certain specific investigation relative to six enumerated items and my reply to you of August 12, 1964, forwarding the results of investigation with the exception of items five and six.

Enclosed herewith are two copies of a memorandum dated August 27, 1964, at Dallas, Texas, along with the five property receipts attached as mentioned therein. This concludes investigation requested in item number six.

For your information, the request in item number five that we attempt to locate and identify the postal clerk with whom Ruby spoke on the early morning of November 23, 1963; was discussed with Mr. Stuart R. Pollak of your staff on July 30, 1964. He was advised of our previous investigation to identify the postal clerk which was furnished to you in the report of Special Agent Manning C. Clements at Dallas, Texas, dated January 17, 1964, page 160. Mr. Pollak stated that in view of the prior investigation it would not be necessary to pursue this particular matter further.

This concludes the investigation as requested in your letter of July 23, 1964.
