ORVIEL SMITH, Deputy Sheriff, Dallas County, Isxas, was interviewed on August 21, 1964.

Mr. SMITH stated that he was not present during the major part of the interview and SWITH stated that he kept no notes and did not try to remember what the questions and answers were. He had not discussed with anyone the questions and answers that he heard during the brief period he was present. Mr. SMITH stated he had no idea as to how this information get into the hands of unauthorized persons and wanted to state that he did not give such information to anyone.
