By Bureau airtel to Dallas dated 8/26/64 enclosing copies of President Commission's letter dated 8/25/64, requesting specific investigation to identify "JOHNNIE" (LNU), an employee at a parking garage near the corner of Jackson and Field Streets in Dallas, Texas, who was reportedly a witness to a conversation on Saturday morning, November 23, 1963, between HARRY OLSEN, his wife, and RUBY.

Enclosed herewith to the Bureau are ten copies of letterhead memorandum incorporating the results of the interview of "JOHNNIE", who is actually JOHN J. SIMPSON, JR.

It is noted that SIMPSON was previously interviewed by Bureau Agents regarding another phase of the assassination on January 28, 1964, and the results were reported on FD-302 on Page 148 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING, 2/11/64, at Dallas, captioned "LEE HARVEY OSWALD, Aka; IS - R - CUBA".
