Reference is made to your letter of July 23, 1964, requesting a report of all existing long-distance telephone calls made from the telephones listed to Mr. Harry Olsen and Mrs. Harry Olsen (Kathy Kay Coleman), formerly of Dallas, Texas, who now reside in Long Beach, California.

There are enclosed two copies each of a memorandum dated August 11, 1964, at Dallas, Texas; a memorandum dated August 13, 1964, at Los Angeles, California; and a memorandum dated August 22, 1964, at Las Vegas, Nevada, setting forth the desired information.

You will note that in your letter of July 20, 1964, you requested toll call records for the telephones of Mr. and Mrs. Olsen for the period 10:00 p.m., November 23, 1963, through November 24, 1963, which falls within the period covered by your request of July 23, 1964, and the desired information is included in the enclosed memoranda.

This concludes the investigation requested in your letter of July 23, 1964.

NOTE:

Harry Olsen is an ex-Dallas police officer who, since the assassination, married Kathy Kay Coleman, one of Ruby's ex-strippers. Ruby, when interviewed by the Commission on 6/7/64, stated that he met the Olsen's on the street on the early morning of 11/23/63 and had a discussion about the assassination with them. We have interviewed both of the Olsen's and they have testified before the Commission. The Commission requested that we obtain all existing toll records relating to the Olsen's, both in Dallas and at their present residence in California. The telephone companies are usually required to maintain such records for a period of six months. The enclosed memoranda of August 11 and 13, 1964, when initially submitted were not complete in that they did not identify subscribers and it was necessary to send out for corrected and amended pages which arrived at the Bureau 9/3/64.
