Re Bureau airtel 1/19/65 relative to information purported to have originated from THURL EDWARD COLLINS concerning a barmaid he knew as "MILLY" in El Paso.

Page 754, report SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, Dallas, 11/30/63, reflects a card bearing picture of "MILI PERLE," advertising the Carousel Club (operated by RUBY) was among the many items found in the trunk of RUBY's automobile following his arrest 11/24/63.

The above-named was identified as MILI PERELE, a hostess at the Hut Lounge, El Paso, Texas. Interview by SA's GEORGE E. AIFEN, JR., and HAROLD LEON DAVIS, 11/29/63, El Paso, appears on Page 159 of SA CLEMENTS' report, 12/6/63.

The wording of the FD-302 interview would infer the interview was conducted in the Hut Lounge. It is suggested this woman is the person referred to as "MILLY" by Mr. COLLINS and that the exhibition of a photograph by FBI agents to employees of the hrs, if such occurred, was likely in connection with efforts to locate this woman for interview. It is further suggested that Mr. COLLINS may well be mistaken as to the date
